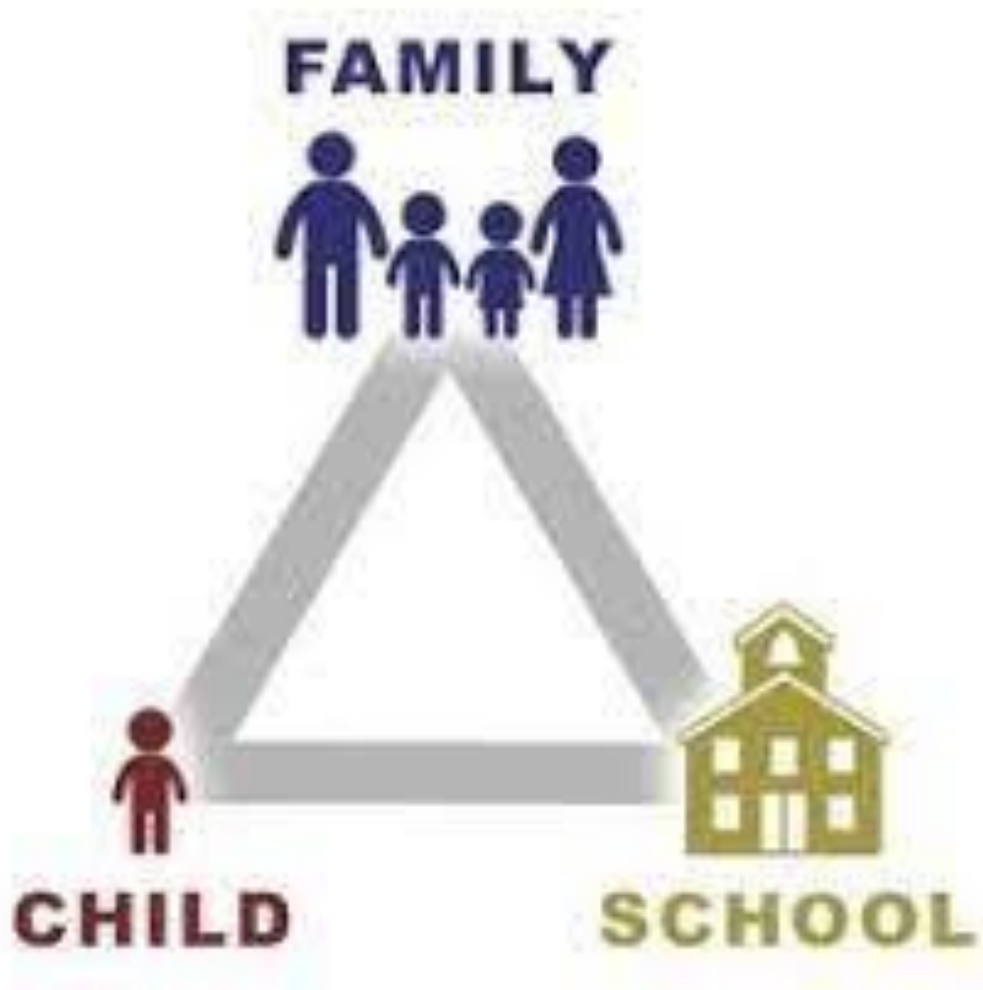
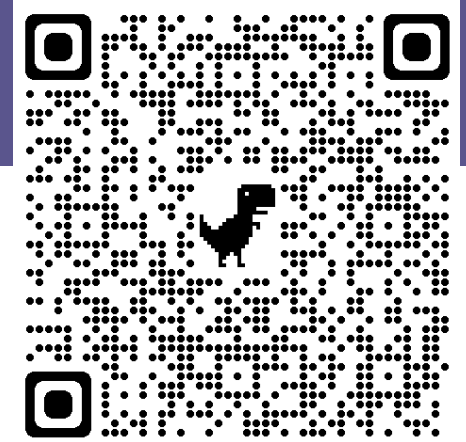
Our School Day

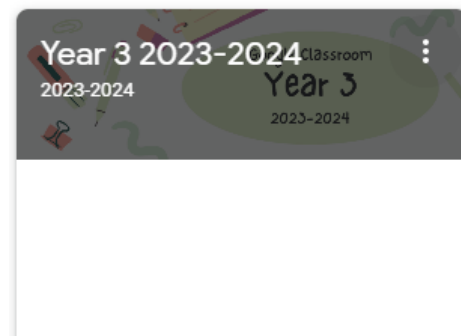
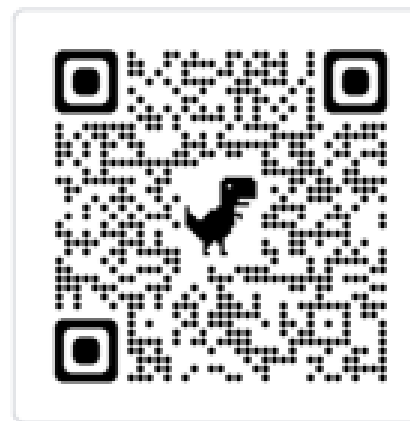
Allergy Awareness

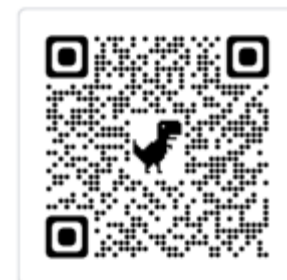
HSPTA is our registered charity with the aim of raising money for the infant and junior school which is run by a group of parent volunteers
