# High School Musical:



The performances are taking place on **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> July (6-7pm) and Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July (6pm-7pm).** 

On both evenings, we ask that the children are collected/ walk home from school at their normal time of 3.20pm and return to school at 5:40pm dressed in their costumes, with basic makeup done (optional). Any face painting required shall then be done on arrival at school. They should enter via the school office.

**Collection:** should you be attending these performances or not, please collect your child 15 minutes after the end of show time from the normal year 6 gate (gate 2 next to the kitchen). The end of show timings are approximate.

What is great about costumes this year is that as the production is set in a school, the children can where lots of their clothes. Published on google classroom next week will be ideas for their costumes based on the different roles/groups that the children have within High School Musical. Details of when we need them in school to rehearse with will be shared on this document too.

Tickets can be requested closer to the time. We will share final details with you about this at the start of July.

## **Garden Party:**
