Year 4 visit to Butser Hill Ancient Farm – Monday 29 April 2024

We are delighted this year to be able to offer the opportunity to the Year 4 pupils to visit Butser Hill Ancient Farm. Butser Ancient farm is an archaeological open-air museum and archaeological site located near Petersfield, Hampshire. The site has unique Anglo-Saxon buildings, a range of activities and workshops that offer the children hands on experiences, which will support their learning of their next history topic – the Anglo-Saxons.

We plan to:

- Leave school by coach at 09.00 am to enable us to arrive and begin by 10am.
- Leave Butser Hill at 2.30 pm to enable us to be back by 3.20pm.

- Activities: Saxon Tour, Artefact handling
