

Social Story for Transition day 2026

On Monday 29th June, I will arrive at school and go to my Year 5 classroom as normal where my teacher will do the register and I will do my normal morning task. After the register, my teacher will read out the new class lists so I will know what class I am in next year. I might feel a bit excited and a bit nervous but this is perfectly normal. If I feel worried about anything, I can ask my teacher or the teaching assistant in my class who will help answer my questions. I need to remember that all of the teachers in Hiltingbury Junior School are lovely and whatever class I am in, I will have a great year!

At 9.30am, I will go to assembly where Miss Loosemore and Mrs Hartley will talk all about the theme we are going to explore during the day in our new classes. When I go to assembly, I will need to take my pencil case and water bottle with me. After assembly, I will lead out with my new teacher and go to my new classroom. In class, we will do some activities to get to know each other.



Then it will be breaktime. My new teacher will walk me out to break so I know where to go. I will be able to play with all my friends at breaktime, even if some of them are not in my new class. If I would like my snack at breaktime, I will be able to walk back to my locker to get it.

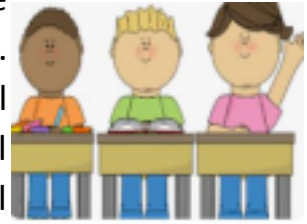
