Then it will be breaktime. My new teacher will walk me out to break so I know where to go. I will be able to play with all my friends at breaktime, even if some of them are not in my new class.

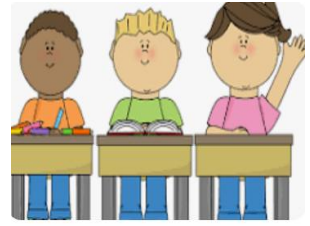
