



Online Safety Newsletter #2

Last Friday, the children participated in our yearly Online Safety Day, the topic was centred on 'All fun and games- exploring respect and relationships online.' The day started with an assembly led by our amazing Cyber Ambassadors and a Kahoot quiz on online safety scenarios. The Cyber Ambassadors did a great job presenting and I am very proud of them! A big well done to the winners, who were 5M (not a fix I promise!) The children then undertook a range of practical activities in their classrooms, from making online safety quizzes on scratch, safety snakes and online ladders, animations and much more! We also had the privilege of a PCSO visiting all classes in the morning. This gave the children a chance to ask any questions on being safe in the community.
