Geography	<b>Dangerous Geography – In our Dangerous Geography unit we learn about how, why and where volcanos and earthquakes occur, along with the impact of these both on human and physical geography</b>						
R.E.	<b>Ritual - Here we explore the importance of ritual within the Islam faith and discuss why ritual is important to all faiths and within our daily lives</b>						
PDL	<b>Rights, Responsibilities and the Law – Here we explore our own rights, the rights of others and how these link to the law</b>
