Dear Year 6 Parents and Carers,

Please find below a few final reminders and information for events and the Summer 2 term.

Final information and reminders for Aladdin:

The performances are taking place on Wednesday 29th (5.45pm - 7pm) and Thursday 30th June (4.30pm - 5.45pm).

On Wednesday 29th June, we ask that the children are collected/ walk home from school at their normal time of 3.20pm and return to school at 4.45pm dressed in their costumes, with basic makeup done (optional): foundation and blush (plus eyeshadow, mascara and lipstick for the girls). Any face painting required shall then be done on arrival at school, they should enter via the school office.

On Thursday 30th June, we plan for children to stay at school ready for the performance at 4.30pm. They will need to bring their costumes back into school on the morning of the 30th, and a snack to have at the end of the school day before the show. Please can they also bring their basic makeup to apply (optional) - help will be provided as needed and the required face painting will be done at school.

We plan to give the children an ice pop too - whilst we have allergy details, should you not wish your child to have an ice pop, please let us know by **4pm on Wednesday (29th June)**.

Collection: should you be attending these performances or not, please collect your child 15 minutes after the end of show time from the normal year 6 gate (gate 2 next to the kitchen). The end of show timings are approximate.

Medication:

• Staff will carry a small emergency supply of Calpol and Piriton. However, if your child requires any regular medicines - eg: Piriton for Hayfever or Calpol for Migraines, you must provide a supply for them.











- If your child requires travel sickness medication please ensure they are given this before they
 come to school on Monday 4th July and provide enough for the return journey along with a
 completed form.
- Children MUST NOT carry any medication, other than inhalers, in their luggage.

- The children need to be dropped off at **Gate 2** (Hall side entrance) between **9am and 9.15am**.
- Each pupil must bring a packed lunch and drink.
